

Env, Health and Safety Policy

This document has been prepared in accordance the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act 2005. The Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (General Application) Regulations 2007 - 2020 and the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work (Construction) Regulations 2013 – 2020, ISO 45001 Occupational Health and Safety, ISO 14001 Environmental management and applies to all persons carrying out any activity including the employees of sub-contractors employed by Flood Precast.

Flood Precast Policy aims to prevent incidents and ill health by documenting, implementing, maintaining and continually improving our Environmental, Health and Safety Management System. The system is established to control Environmental, health and safety risks arising from all our work activities.

The purpose of this policy is to identify the framework, objectives, processes and procedures that, through appropriate delegation of roles and responsibilities will so far as is reasonably practicable ensure the Environmental, safety, health and welfare of all our employees, whilst at work and to provide such information, training and supervision needed for this purpose

- ✓ Provide and maintain safe and healthy working conditions in so far as is reasonably practicable to prevent work related injury and/or ill health.
- ✓ Ensure that environmental impacts are controlled and minimised
- ✓ Provision of adequate welfare facilities.
- ✓ Eliminate the hazards and reduce the health and safety risks associated with our by using the hierarchy of controls methodology.
- ✓ Provide essential, relevant and appropriate information, training, instruction and supervision to all employees and anyone working under the control of Flood Precast.
- ✓ Comply with our legal duties and requirements.
- ✓ Provide a facility for communication, consultation and participation of employees in matters relating to Environmental, health and safety in the workplace.
- ✓ Ensure Env, health & safety is not compromised by other business activities.
- ✓ Continual improvement of our Environmental, health and safety management system.


The allocation of duties for EHS matters and particular arrangements to implement the policy are set out in the Environmental, Health & Safety Statement. Flood Precast senior management give their full support and commitment on all env, health & safety issues and will make available all necessary resources to achieve the company env, health & safety policy objectives.

The policy successful implementation relies on a team effort by all who ensure that all roles and responsibilities are fulfilled which includes compliance with all legal requirements. Objectives are set at the annual management review meeting and communicated to all within the organisation.

Due to the nature of our business, that is being a sub-contract company, it is our aim to ensure that our employees work to the standard of site contractor's health & safety plan or to our own env, health & safety policy if greater.

Flood Precast Env, Health & Safety policy is reviewed at least annually or when changes occur and is distributed to all Contract Managers, Agents and Designated Supervisors and shall be available at locations where the Flood Precast carries on its business.
